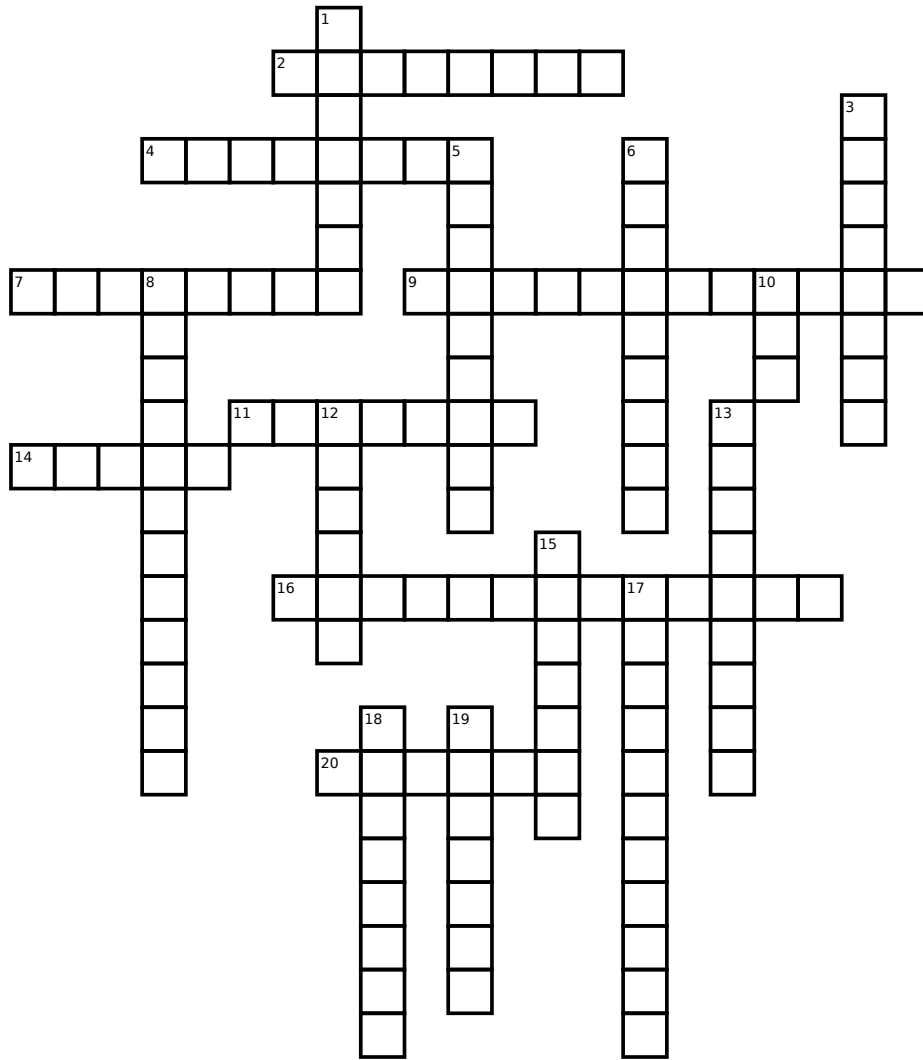


CROSSWORD #13
